4 Standing Committee Reports

- **4.1 COPAC Update:** Victoria not able to attend no update this month
- **4.2 Hot Lunch Program:** (Heidi Starr). Feb. Hot Dog lunch went well. Next Hot Lunch: GoGo sushi, followed by Boston Pizza. System not set up to carry a balance. Core group of 5-6 volunteers.

4.3 Fundraising:

Bottle Drive – Scheduling March 19th bottle drive at OTS. Will start advertising March 4th to OTS community & general community. Utilize online sign-up again. Any funds raised will go towards paying down Gardom Lake costs for those students who volunteer. Rebecca will arrange opportunities for students who can't attend bottle drive to do early pickups to assist with costs or secondary alternative to assist with sorting during school lunch hour(s).

November Sip & Shop – Wine donations – Rebecca will tackle letters in coming weeks.

4.3.1 Reminder of Ongoing Fundraisers:

Save-On Foods – Purchase gift card then pay for groceries. Portion to PAC Nature's Fare – Bring in receipts & PAC gets portion of total Oliver's Labels – Portion of purchase goes back to PAC

5 Old Business:

5.1 Uniform Sale – Shop & swap April 8th (week before Easter). Sizing set will be available. Uniform fittings will only happen in Vancouver.

5.2 H.S. Grenda PAC – asking for Grade 5 student's gaming funds (n=28, total \$560) to assist with setting up social activities. Vote not to transfer funds to H.S. Grenda.

5.3 Cambridge Contract – looking for 3 year renewal at same cost point. Unanimous vote to continue. Reiterate the importance of uniforms in the school.

5.4 School Pictures – Feedback that people would like to keep the pictures, but standardize the look/framing to update them or start digitization project.

5.5 Make It Sow Fundraiser – Five day turnaround once they receive your order. 50% kick back. Timing not quite right - revisit in November for next year.
