1. Welcome:

2. Standing Committee Reports

a. Uniform Committee:

c. Yearbook Committee:

- i. Description of how the yearbook has run in previous years, with two parents, one collecting and sorting images and the second putting everything into the yearbook format for printing.

d. Hot Lunch:

- i. Update from Danielle Allingham. We have have started a trial period with a new online ordering program. It is free for the first 3 months and then should cost between \$250-\$350/year to run after that.

- iii. Have decided rather than running the recycling program, which students lost interest in after a while, to use biodegradable cups etc. Originally purchased through the Wholesale Club in Vernon, we will also explore options through Sysco.
- iv. Looking for someone who will be willing to take over the hot lunch program once Danielle's kids are no longer at the school. Discussion around possibly using more (or all) restaurants simply for ease of the program, so that the program can continue to run.
