4.3 Fundraising:

A. Bottle Drive (Saturday, September 18th) – will aim for 9:00-9:15 arrival. Breaking volunteer slots into 2.5hr shifts. Will need to look at other volunteer opportunities to get money for Grade 5 hoodies. Possibility if it goes well to do another drive in the Spring and make it an annual event. Used uniform sale/exchange to run concurrently. **Actions:** Bring cans, need bags, another social media update, Rebecca to create graphic to share & to confirm whether OTS account is still open for people to donate to separately throughout the year.
